## Novice classes

15. Apples, dessert - 1 plate of 3 fruits of same variety.
16. Apples, culinary - 1 plate of 3 fruits of same variety.
17. Pears - 1 plate of 3 fruits of same variety.
18. Berries - 1 plate of 12 fruits of same variety.
19. Any other fruit not previously listed.
20. A display of 3 different kinds of fruit, 2 of the same variety of each kind.

## RULES

1. The show will be held in the Sunley Room, Brammall Learning Centre, Harlow Carr Gardens, Crag Lane, Beckwithshaw, Harrogate HG3 1QB.
2. The show will be conducted in accordance with the rules and standards contained in the RHS show handbook, 2016 edition except where under this schedule these obviously do not apply.
3. Throughout the schedule the words "kinds" and "varieties" are used in the following sense:apples and pears are distinct kinds; Cox and Bramley are distinct varieties.
4. The number of each kind of exhibit in "Collections" or "Any Other Fruit" classes must be the same as in similar individual classes unless specified otherwise.
5. Classes 1 to 14 are open classes. Anyone may enter these classes.
6. Classes 15 to 20 inclusive are novice classes and each class is open only to those who have not previously won a first place in that novice class or the equivalent open class in any previous NFG show.
7. All exhibits must be bona-fide products of the exhibitor and have been cultivated by them.
8. Entry to all classes is free and the entry form is below. Entry forms will also be available at the venue from 9.30 am on the day of the show.
9. Entries will be accepted from 9.30 am to 12 noon on the day of the show. Staging must be completed by 12.30 pm when the Sunley Room will be closed for judging.
10. Plates and baskets for staging fruit will be provided.
11. All exhibits must bear a class card with the class number placed uppermost. Class cards will be issued at the entry table.
12. Where possible the variety of each exhibit should be indicated. Variety cards are available from the entry table.
13. Exhibitors may make multiple entries in any class for which they are eligible but only one prize per class will be allowed for any exhibitor.
14. Exhibits not conforming to the schedule will be disqualified.
15. The judge's decision will be final.
16. Except for classes 3 and 14, prize money will be: 1 st: $\quad £ 10 ; \quad 2 \mathrm{nd}: \quad £ 8 ; \quad 3 \mathrm{rd}$ : $\quad$ £6

For class 3 prize money will be $\quad$ 1st: $£ 20 ; 2$ nd: $£ 16 ; 3$ rd: $\quad £ 12$
For class 14 prize money will be 1 1st $£ 25 ; 2$ 2nd: $£ 20 ; 3$ rd: $£ 15$
A prize of $£ 30.00$ will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most points in the show.
A prize of $£ 30.00$ will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most points in the novice classes.
17. Points will be awarded in each class as follows: 1st: 6 points; 2nd: 4 points; 3rd: 2 points
18. The prize certificates for the exhibitors with the most points in show will be presented at 2.30 p.m.
19. Prize money may be collected at the end of the show.
20. Exhibits must not be removed from display until after 4.00 p.m.
21. The show organisers can accept no responsibility for the safety of exhibits. All reasonable care will be taken but exhibits will be staged at the owner's risk.
